TRASH, BULK & RECYCLING COLLECTION SCHEDULE

No Pickup on Municipal holidays

Garbage and recyclables must be at curbside between 6:00 PM and 10:00 PM on the night before collection. Residents are responsible for preventing and cleaning all illegal dumping on their property. To report illegal dumping, residents can call 973.733.4311 or 973.733.6000 (NPD).

ZONE A

MONDAY COLLECTION

Household Trash

Place trash in sturdy can with lid.

Absolutely no grocery or shopping bags.

Recyclable newspapers, magazines, cardboard, cereal boxes and junk mail. These items shall be bundled with twine or placed securely in paper bags. No plastic bags.

THURSDAY COLLECTION

Household Trash

Recyclable metal: soda cans, food cans

Recyclable glass: glass jars, food jars, liquor bottles

Recyclable plastic: milk jugs, soda and water bottles, juice bottles, laundry detergent

Recyclables must be at curbside between 6:00 PM and 10:00 PM on the night before collection.

YARD WASTE COLLECTION

3rd Wednesday of each month

Includes leaves and small twigs tied in a bundle

Please put yard waste in a brown bag or tied in a bundle

APPLIANCES/WHITE GOODS

White Goods: refrigerators, air conditioners and other appliances require an appointment.

No Pick Ups for Construction Debris or Auto Parts!

ELECTRONICS

Newark residents can dispose of old electronics (computers, TV's, video monitors, etc.) by recycling them at the City of Newark's Recycling Depot located at 62 Frelinghuysen Avenue at the corner of Miller Street, between 8:30 AM and 3:00 PM, Monday through Friday.



ZONE B

TUESDAY COLLECTION

Household Trash

Place trash in sturdy can with lid.

Absolutely no grocery or shopping bags.

Recyclable newspapers, magazines, cardboard, cereal boxes and junk mail. These items shall be bundled with twine or placed securely in paper bags. No plastic bags.

FRIDAY COLLECTION

Household Trash

Recyclable metal: soda cans, food cans

Recyclable glass: glass jars, food jars, liquor bottles

Recyclable plastic: milk jugs, soda, and water bottles, juice bottles, laundry detergent

Recyclables must be at curbside between 6:00 PM and 10:00 PM on the night before collection.

BULK COLLECTION

2nd Wednesday of each month

Includes chairs, covered mattresses, dressers, couches, tables, rugs, exercise equipment, closets, vanities
No pick up of automobile parts, bumpers, construction debris, drywall, glass & windows, paint, roofing tiles/shingles, tires

Bulk trash pick-ups are limited by law to 10 items per building regardless of the number of tenants or Apartments on bulk collection day

Violators will be fined \$250 per item over the 10-item limit!



Trade Waste Permits Required for Business & Commercial Property Owners

Ironbound District business and commercial property owners are reminded that the City of Newark, by ordinance, will not collect trash or recycling from any business in the city. Businesses are required to have a valid Trade Waste Permit ensuring a pick-up service agreement is in place and will be fined if they do not have and display the permit or leave trash and/or recycling uncollected. As a supplemental service provider to the City of Newark, the same rules apply to the IBID's street maintenance team regarding collection and disposal, including recyclable materials.
